**Event Description:** Martin Luther King Jr. Day, recognized as a National Day of Service, **encourages all Americans to volunteer and contribute to making a positive change in their communities**. Each year, SOLVE marks this day by hosting volunteer projects that honor Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s life and legacy as well as enhance the environment for everyone. This year, the **event at Irving Park in Portland** is **proudly presented by Kaiser Permanente**, bringing SOLVE and volunteers together to support the Historic Albina Neighborhood and surrounding area.

**Why:** MLK Day of Service is a community-driven initiative paying tribute to Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s enduring legacy. Volunteers have the opportunity to not only commemorate Dr. King's remarkable life and impact but also to make a significant difference in this iconic neighborhood and community.

**Media Crews:** Arrive by 9:45 am under the covered basketball courts on the corner of NE Fremont and NE 7th to see approximately 200 volunteers of all ages being greeted by SOLVE staff, checking in, collecting their cleanup supplies, receiving a safety speech and event debrief, and then heading out in groups to pick up litter in the surrounding area. The event will run from 10 am to 12 am, with volunteers expected to pick up trash along NE MLK Jr Blvd and the adjacent neighborhoods.

This event will have plenty of visuals of volunteers picking up litter, making for great community packages, VOs, and VOSOTS.
