Legacy Health issues COVID-19 visitor guidelines for all medical centers in Oregon and Washington

PORTLAND, Ore. (March 16, 2020) – To protect patients, staff, and the public, Legacy Health has issued strict visitor guidelines for all Legacy medical centers in Oregon and Washington, while COVID-19 is considered a public health threat.

The general public (anyone who is not accompanying a patient) is not allowed within our Legacy medical centers until further notice, including our cafeterias, waiting rooms, and indoor and outdoor meeting spaces. There are a few exceptions to the COVID-19 visitor guidelines; people are encouraged to go to <u>Legacyhealth.org</u> for detailed information.
