WINTER WEATHER AND POSSIBLE LOCAL FLOODING

Heavy rainfall and winter weather are impacting Lincoln County and surrounding areas.

The National Weather Service has issued a Flood Warning for the <u>Siletz River</u> in effect from Thursday, December 18th to Friday, December 19th. Current estimates show the river is expected to rise above flood stage (16 feet) this evening and crest around 24.3 feet later tonight. It is expected to fall below flood stage Friday morning.

With heavy rain, debris, and rising river levels, roads may become unsafe. Significant rainfall and wind may cause hazardous conditions including local flooding and possible landslides.
